Here, users will be able to discover and connect with organisations across Wales. Currently, the directory provides information related to the following organisations based in Wales:

- 260+ Life Sciences Companies (Industry)
- Health organisations Health Boards, Trusts, Regional Innovation and Communication Hubs (RIC Hubs), Regional Partnership Boards (RPBs) etc.
- Innovation Support Organisations
- Universities
- Intensive Learning Academies (ILAs)

Please note that our directory does not claim to include every organisation in Wales. We are actively developing the directory throughout 2024 and welcome feedback and requests from organisations seeking inclusion. Additionally, it is important to be aware that social care organisations in Wales will not be included, as they are already accessible via <u>Care</u> Inspectorate Wales.

Each listing will be categorised by organisation type and sector, allowing users to filter and search based on:

- Type: Public, Private, NHS, Government (Local, UK, Wales)
- **Sector:** Healthcare, Social Care, Life Sciences, Pharmaceuticals, Medical Technology, Digital Health, Industry, Academia, Innovation Support

Overview: We recommend a maximum of 100 words. The shorter the description, the easier it is for users to digest the information. Website link: Geography: Wales Sector: A maximum of two-three tags per listing. Services: A maximum of four-six tags per listing. Type: Options include: Public / Private / NHS / Government Specialism: A maximum of five-eight words.

Change requests must be authorised by the relevant personnel from organisations listed in the directory. We would expect to receive these from authorised senior personnel such as, Director of Communications, CEO, etc. before any amends are made.

Annual updates

Once a year, we'll review the database and make necessary updates. These annual updates will be carried out in December to align with the Office for Life Sciences database updates.
