What is it?

The Innovation Directory is an online resource located on the Life Sciences Hub Wales website. It offers users essential details about organisations in Wales actively involved in the advancement of health and social care innovation.

Here, users will be able to discover and connect with organisations across Wales. Currently, the directory provides information related to the following organisations based in Wales:

- 500+ life sciences companies (Industry)
- Health organisations – health boards, trusts, Regional Innovation and Communication Hubs (RIC Hubs), Regional Partnership Boards (RPBs) etc.
- Innovation support organisations
- Universities
- Intensive Learning Academies (ILAs)

Please note that our directory does not claim to include every organisation in Wales. We continuously update the directory and welcome feedback and requests from organisations seeking inclusion.

Additionally, it is important to be aware that social care organisations in Wales will not be included, as they are already accessible via [Care Inspectorate Wales](#).

Each listing is categorised by organisation type and sector, allowing users to filter and search based on:

- **Organisation type:** Business Incubator, Charity, Government: Local, National And UK, NHS, Not-for-profit, Private, University, Professional Organisation, Research Organisation

- **Sector:** Academia, Biotechnology, Business Incubator, Digital Health, Healthcare, Industry (Other), Innovation Support Services, Life Sciences, Medical Technology, NHS, Pharmaceuticals, Research, Social Care, Training
